Guidelines for the implementation of YSR-Sunna Vaddi Panta Runalu (Zero Percent Interest Crop Loans) Scheme

The Government of Andhra Pradesh has announced Sunna Vaddi Panta Runalu Scheme which aims at securing the farmers from falling into debt trap and also to mitigate the financial burden of the farmers / cultivators.

2. The scheme provides Interest Free loans under “YSR-Sunna Vaddi Panta Runalu” Scheme from Kharif 2019-20 onwards to all the farmers who avail crop loans upto Rs.1.00 Lakh and repay within the stipulated time, i.e, maximum period of one year. The criteria compare with the existing guidelines under Interest Subvention Scheme of GOI and also the Kisan Credit Card norms.

Modalities for implementation of the scheme:

Each Bank may designate one of their Branches as Nodal Branch. The RRBs may designate one of the branches at their Head Quarters as Nodal branch, while DCCBs will authorize APCOB to submit the claims.

- The State Government will reimburse the interest claims directly to the respective bank accounts of the farmers by **Aadhar Enabled Payment System (AEPS) / Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) through e-Kuber soon after receiving of the claims.**
- Upon payment of total Principal amount and interest by the farmer on or before due date, the details of the interest amount @ 4% on Crop Loan paid by the farmer are to be provided by the Banks/the Nodal Branch identified for this purpose to the office of the Commissioner and Director of Agriculture.
- The claims are to be submitted to the Office of Commissioner & Director of Agriculture through Sunna Vaddi Panta Runalu portal vide <http://ysrsvpr.ap.gov.in> (exclusively created for the purpose) by the Nodal Branches of the banks.
- Nodal branch has to submit the details of interest subsidy in the frequent intervals of fortnightly/monthly along with the information as required for RTGS/NEFT transaction.
- On receipt of the details from Nodal branch, the office of the Commissioner & Director of Agriculture will consolidate and transfer the funds from PD account to the respective farmers bank accounts **by Aadhar Enabled Payment System (AEPS) / Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) through e-Kuber.**
- The Office of the Commissioner & Director of Agriculture has a dedicated portal <http://ysrsvpr.ap.gov.in> to process these transactions.
- One Template is to be submitted by the branches to the Nodal branch at frequent intervals. The format should contain the details of the farmer, survey/khata number, village, mandal, GEN/SC/ST/Women as GoAP need these details for release of amount. The Nodal branch will submit this information in YSRVPR Portal to the Office of Commissioner & Director of Agriculture, A.P, Guntur. The banks have to submit the data as per the format given below.

- While payment of the interest subsidy claims, the Office of Commissioner & Director of Agriculture will verify the farmers details with E-Crop booking details for providing the benefit under the scheme to the actual cultivators only and accordingly Bankers are advised to extend crop loans to actual cultivators recorded in E-Crop.
- Necessary changes in the portal are to be carried out by the service provider M/s Aegis Consulting Services.
